

Care of Your Nose after Rhinoplasty

Correct post-operative care is essential to the success of the surgery.

Regular Post-Operative Care:

- Use ice packs over the head and eyes for 2-3 days
- > Apply antibiotic ointment (if prescribed) to the inside of the nostrils 3 to 4 times a day
- Antibiotic tablets are continued for 1 week or as prescribed
- Keep the plaster cast dry until it is removed (generally at 1 week)
- Keep your head elevated, do not bend over or strain excessively
- > Douche your nose at least 6 times a day with Saline spray once the internal splints are removed
- > (The more you spray your nose the better and quicker it will heal)

Pain:

- > Headache and pain is usually not severe
- It is OK to use: Paracetamol, Codeine, Panadeine, Digesic, or Mersyndol
- Do NOT take Aspirin, Neurofen or medicines containing NSAIDS as these may cause your nose to bleed (Ask your chemist or call Dr Shahidi)

Blockage, Runny Nose:

- The nasal airway is often very blocked in the first week due to swelling. It will settle over time by itself and once the splint is removed
- Anti-histamines may help runny nose such as Telfast, Claratyne, Hismanal, and Zyrtec
- Do NOT blow your nose during the first week, as it could cause a nose bleed

Bloody Discharge:

- A small amount of bloodstained discharge is normal. Change the bolster as needed
- Expect decreasing amounts over 7-14 days depending on the surgery preformed
- > The bolster can be removed once nasal discharge has settled
- Nasal and Facial Appearance:
- In the first week the nostrils will be asymmetric and the tip of the nose may seem raised
- The shape of the nose takes many weeks to months to settle
- There will be swelling around the nose and cheeks
- Resting with your head up reduces swelling

Make-up: May be used at any time

Bruising Variable: Use Hirudoid cream 1 week after surgery

Return to Work: Usually at 1-2 weeks Strenuous Exercise or travel: 4 weeks

Contact Sports: Avoid for at least 3 months after Rhinoplasty Eye glasses: Do not wear glasses for 4-6 weeks after Rhinoplasty
